Prize Award, and a Professional

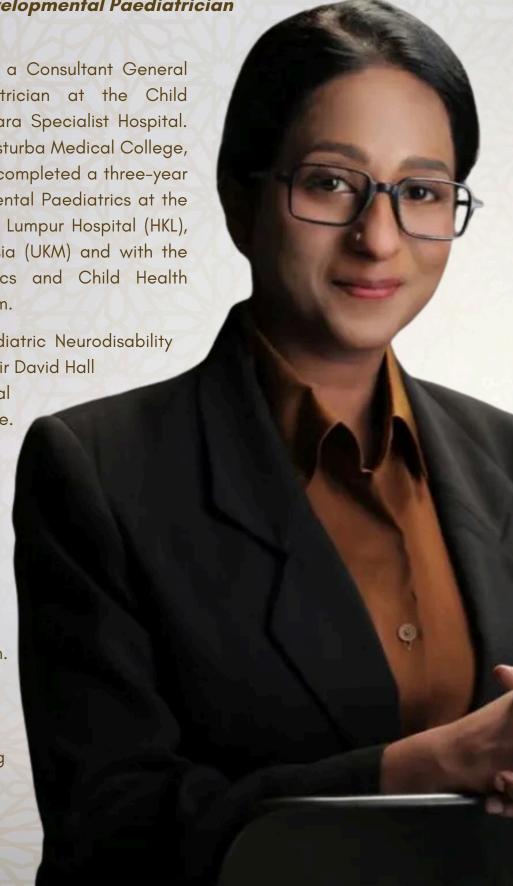
Diploma in UK Medical Practice.

Neurodevelopmental Paediatrics: Guiding Children and Families Through Growth and Challenges

Neurodevelopmental paediatrics is a subspecialty of child health that examines how the developing brain and nervous system together with a child's environment shape learning, behaviour and everyday functioning. It encompasses the assessment and management of conditions such as autism spectrum disorder, attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder (ADHD), learning difficulties, speech and language delays, cerebral palsy, dual sensory loss and complex developmental profiles. These conditions are often lifelong but can be significantly improved with timely recognition and appropriate interventions.

Rather than looking only at a single symptom, neurodevelopmental paediatricians take a holistic, child-centred approach by combining medical history, physical and neurological examination, developmental testing, and information from parents, teachers and therapists to understand a child's strengths and challenges. This detailed assessment leads to clear diagnoses, tailored interventions and coordinated support at home, school and in the community. Neurodevelopmental paediatricians also pay close attention to co-existing medical or mental health issues such as epilepsy, anxiety, or sleep disturbances, which can affect a child's progress.







Because neurodevelopmental issues often overlap, this field is inherently multidisciplinary. Neurodevelopmental paediatricians work closely with speech and language therapists, occupational therapists, psychologists, educators and community organisations to design individualised care plans.

The goal is not only to manage symptoms but also to help children develop life skills, social relationships and confidence. Early recognition and intervention can greatly improve outcomes and empower families. At every stage, we emphasise collaboration with parents so that they become active partners in their child's journey.





Neurodevelopmental paediatricians also play an important role in supporting schools, NGOs and policy makers by providing objective assessments and clear, evidence-based reports. These reports can inform educational planning, therapy programmes, benefits applications and other decisions that directly affect a child's future.

As I often remind families and colleagues:

"Thorough, evidence-driven evaluations build trust
between families, schools and clinicians." At the Child
Development Clinic, Damansara Specialist Hospital, I strive to
make neurodevelopmental assessments accessible, evidencebased and family-friendly. My goal is always to help each
child reach their full potential and to support the families and
professionals who care for them.

Sleep Problems in Children:

Why Rest Matters More Than You Think



Sleep plays a vital role in a child's growth, learning, and behaviour. Yet, many children struggle with sleep disturbances such as insomnia, restless sleep, night terrors, or sleep-disordered breathing. These issues can affect school performance, mood, and even physical health.

Paediatricians assess sleep concerns by looking at bedtime routines, daily habits, and medical factors like enlarged tonsils or allergies. Solutions range from improving sleep hygiene (consistent schedules, reducing screen time) to medical interventions when needed. Parents are also guided on recognising red flags such as snoring, pauses in breathing, or frequent awakenings.





Good sleep is essential for brain development. With early recognition and appropriate interventions, many sleep problems can be resolved helping children wake refreshed, focus better, and thrive both at home and in school.
